The High-Level Taskforce on COVID-19 Pandemic



The High-Level Taskforce on COVID-19 Pandemic held its 29th Meeting on the afternoon of Sunday 19th April 2020 under the Chairmanship of H. E. Dr Riek Machar Teny-Dhurgon, the First Vice President and Deputy Chairman of the High-Level Taskforce on COVID-19 Pandemic.

The High-Level Taskforce was briefed on the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Situation in South Sudan, the Region and the Globe by the Honourable Minister for Health.

The Honourable Minister informed the Taskforce that South Sudan still has four (4) confirmed cases, the seven(7) test ran yesterday included contacts from Torit were tested negative and (39) tests of samples collected today from contacts whose quarantine time





has elapsed, are currently running, the results will be announced tomorrow.

The High-Level Taskforce directs the Ministry of Health to follow up with Ministry of the Finance and Planning on payment of the approved CoVID-19 budget of Ministries of Health, of Environment, of Higher Education, of interior and The High-Level Task Force operations budget.


The High-Level Taskforce directs the Juba University representative to participate on the High Level Technical Secretariat meetings to access the strategic plans and response.

The High-Level Taskforce directs the Ministry of Environment to work with City Council to remove piled garbage from Juba town and disposal of medical waste in collaboration with ministry of Health.

On Requests for Special Permission to entre or leave the country,

The High-Level Taskforce resolves as follows;

- 1-Grant Special Permission to Medivac of Mr. Majier Riak Makol from Juba to Nairobi on 21st April 2020.
- 2-Grant Special Permission to Episcopal Church of South Sudan Northern Bahr Ghazal to allow water tank vehicle to travel from Juba to Wau by land.





- 3-Grant Special Permission to transport the remains of the late sister of Archbishop Most Rev Gabriel Roriec Jur of the Reformed Episcopal Church of South Sudan from Juba to Yirol.
- 4-Grant Special Permission to Nile Drilling and Service for landing and Positioning of Aircraft Fokor 50 with registration 5Y-JXN at Juba Internal Airport on 21st of April 2020, on board thirty one (31) passengers.
- 5-Grant Special Permission to ICRC for Cargo flight on April 20th to April 27th from Juba to Malakal, Rumbek and Maiwut, Bor, Wau, Ieer, Akobo and Yei.
